The village architecture features many archways and a labyrinth of charming cobblestone streets. Famous for its spectacular views, impressive architecture and stunning geographical location, the village also has a lovely chapel dating back to the 1300s, magnificent botanical gardens built on the site of a former fortress and La Chèvre d'Or, a two Michelin star restaurant with a reputation for some of the finest gastronomy on the Riviera.
- Step back in time with a visit to the enchanting medieval village of Saint Paul de Vence, one of the Riviera's most famous treasures. Perched high atop a mountain, the village is framed by exceptional panoramic views that stretch from the Mediterranean coast to the Southern Alpine mountains. Follow in the footsteps of artists who fell under the spell of the village, including Marc Chagall, Pablo Picasso, Henri Matisse and Jean-Michel Folon, for a first-hand perspective of the vistas they immortalized. Visit the Fondation Maeght with its curator to enjoy one of the largest and most important collections of 20th century art in Europe.
- Get access at closed door to the Matisse Museum to view one of the world's largest collections of works from all chapters of Henri Matisse's career. Paintings, engravings, sculptures, drawings and hundreds of pieces are on display in the museum which is set in the lovely 17th-century Villa des Arènes. - Discover the Marc Chagall National Museum which houses the largest public collection of his work. The museum features The Bible Illustrations, a series of striking paintings inspired by crucial events from the Old Testament of the Bible, as well as more than 400 paintings, watercolors, ink drawings and pastels.
- Exclusive visit to the Monte Carlo Opera House and Casino. Designed by Charles Garnier under the leadership of Marie Blanc, the Monte Carlo Opera House was inaugurated in 1879. Adjacent to the Monte Carlo Casino, it was designed to exude the same opulent flair. This exceptional Opera House enthralls us all with the eclecticism of its performances and the secrets it keeps. After visiting the public areas of the Opera House, you will enjoy an exclusive enchanting moment in the backstage area where you will have the unique experience of watching dance rehearsals in the studios, which are normally closed to the public. - Behind the Scenes Rehearsal of the Monte Carlo Ballet Company. As the head of the Monte Carlo Ballet Company, Jean-Christophe Maillot has successfully developed a world-renowned troupe, consisting of a group of dancers from 20 different nationalities. When not travelling, the ballet company is rehearsing in the Princess Grace Academy in Monaco. You will have the unique opportunity to sneak onto the backstage of the Princess Grace Academy and watch the private rehearsals.
